

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OCONEE COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY  
IN SUPPORT OF A RECONCILIATION OF THE SC HOUSE REPUBLICAN CAUCUS AND THE  
SC FREEDOM CAUCUS IN ORDER TO UNITE ALL LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS OF THE  
REPUBLICAN PARTY TO BETTER SERVE THE PEOPLE OF SOUTH CAROLINA**

**WHEREAS**, the members of the SC House Republican Caucus and the members of the SC Freedom Caucus have all been duly elected to represent the people of South Carolina;

**WHEREAS**, the ongoing conflict negatively affects the SC Republican Party;

**WHEREAS**, the continuing legal battles negatively affect the South Carolina taxpayers;


